#### SCHOLARSHIP COSTS FOR A COYOTE STUDENT-ATHLETE

For decades, a full scholarship has been defined by the NCAA as tuition & fees, room, board and books. The demands to balance academics and athletics have grown and most of our students do not have time to engage in part-time or summer employment to supplement the costs of their education. Providing cost of attendance is important and helps address the incidental expenses associated with attending USD.

The cost of attendance allowance can be used for other educational expenses like additional rent, food, school supplies/computer, transportation, clothing and personal items.
