To nominate an individual, you believe is deserving of this higher honor, please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Begin by contacting the individual to be nominated. (Should the person be deceased, please contact a family member.)
 - a. Ask permission for the nomination.
 - b. Obtain a copy of the most recent Curriculum Vitae (CV), if available.
 - c. Seek guidance for the names and contact information for three other individuals who have a strong working knowledge of the contributions of the nominee who you should contact for additional support of the nomination.
- 2. Contact the identified individuals and obtain letters (or video clips) of support.
- 3. Complete the nomination form and submit letters (or video clips) of support for the nomination in a single submission by emailing all materials to Jeanette McGillicuddy at Jeanette.McGillicuddy@gmail.com.

It is important to be concise and thorough with the submitted information. It is the strength of this submission and supporting information that will determine those selected for the award.

The deadline for submission is May 30, 2025.

- Continued affiliated with the SOE and USD.


